WILD CYCLE raced wide through the first turn, moved up to take command with a quarter to run, gained a slight edge and held off PIRATES DEPUTY in the final furlong to gamely prevail. PIRATES DEPUTY was bumped at the start, raced wide through the second turn while advancing, reached the winner nearing the eighth pole but could not get by his stable-mate. FULL POWER AHEAD was bumped at the start, raced wide through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with some late run. TEMPLETON showed no early speed, saved ground early, angled out nearing the quarter and found his best stride late. HONOUR THE WEST was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the inside, offered a bid nearing the quarter and gave way in the drive. SLIMMER TIMMER was bumped at the start, raced between foes early, lacked racing room through the lane and finished willingly. PEDRO VALDIVIA was up close early, raced wide through the second turn and finished with some late run. IMMIGRATION was hustled along to duel for the early advantage, opened a clear lead after going three furlongs and gave way after three-quarters. LIBERTY FOR AL chased the leaders from off the rail, offered a bid nearing the quarter and weakened. FAST MISSILE raced just off the leaders from the inside and failed to threaten. RHYTHM TO RUN was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. LAKESIDE AT LESCHI lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and was eased through the lane.
